Introduction


Checking the effectiveness of teaching learning process requires a well-designed feedback mechanism. This mechanism is required to judge the performance of institute in terms of reaching the intended goals of education. From the analysis of feedback, the strengths and weaknesses of the system can be observed to strengthen the weaker areas. This analysis and remedial measures taken ensure the continual improvisation of the institute. The benefits of this mechanism include making the overall teaching learning environment better. Hence, the college has made a policy decision to collect feedback from all stakeholders to improve the quality of curriculum and overall teaching learning experience.

Collection of Feedback

The feedback is obtained from all stakeholders including students, parents, teachers, alumni, and employers.



The feedback is taken once a year from the students of both UG and PG classes. The feedback is obtained in structured manner through proformas developed for the purpose. The feedback is also obtained in a non-structured manner through meetings conducted by Director-Principal of the college with class representatives from various departments of the college and through alumni gatherings, functions, board of studies etc. The feedback is also collected at the departmental level by Heads of departments to assess the quality of curriculum of the programmes offered by the department. The faculty encourages students to provide the Institute with thoughtful and productive feedback.

The departments also get feedback from alumni and parents through Board of Studies meetings and Parent-teacher meetings respectively.

To get honest and genuine feedback, it is not mandatory for the stakeholders to reveal their identity. The feedback obtained is kept confidential and used only for the purposes of quality enhancement.

From session 2021-22 all structured feedback was collected through online mode to save paper and to make the process of collection and analysis of feedback easy.

Feedback from under-graduate and post-graduate students was collected. The feedback was collected from students through structured proformas on curriculum, teachinglearning process, evaluation process, infrastructure facilities etc.

Feedback from teaching staff was obtained in the form of a questionnaire.

The feedback from parents was obtained through google form shared with them.

Likewise, the feedback from alumni was collected through online mode. Feedback was also collected from employers regarding the knowledge, skills, abilities, and values of the students at the institute during placement drives and job fests.




Analysis of the collected Feedback

The collected data is consolidated and analysed for reaching out to the conclusions and the suggestions are also considered. The tables are prepared, and average scores calculated. The average score less than 3 invites necessary action by the IQAC while parameters having score greater than 3 are considered for suggestions pertaining to these parameters are taken cognizance of. After assessment, the IQAC shares the analysis and detailed suggestions with Director-Principal of the college. The feedback is discussed by the Director-Principal of the college with deans and heads of the departments through meetings.

Action Taken Report

In-depth analysis of the feedback gives insights into the problem areas and the suggestions from various stakeholders are evaluated are examined carefully. After thorough deliberations the course of action to be taken is decided. It is ensured through follow-up that those actions are implemented, and the issues are resolved.



College improvement is the main objective for the design of this feedback system. Feedback responses from both Structured and Non-structured format is helpful in making amendments to curriculum, quality of teaching facilities, placements and other provisions. It is also used to give appreciation to staff to keep them motivated. Feedback shows college a path to review, develop and implement policies and practices in key areas, such as curriculum governance, supervision and monitoring. It enables the college to develop strategies that strengthen the teaching-learning experience.

The insights obtained from feedback are used to make decisions in their light which assist in removing the limitations of the system and gives a better environment for students and teachers alike. The feedback was obtained from all stakeholders both in structured and non-structured manner. The feedback was collected and assessed by the IQAC and shared with Director-Principal of the college to achieve institutional vision and goals.




1. Feedback from Students


The feedback was collected from students through structured proformas on curriculum, teaching-learning process, evaluation process, infrastructure facilities etc. having a total of 13 parameters. The feedback from students was also obtained through meetings of the Director-Principal of the college with class representatives (CRs) from different departments of the college. In these meetings, students were encouraged to share their problems and were asked for suggestions to improve the teaching learning environment. The responses in structured performa were obtained from UG and PG students on a five-point scale and average score was calculated.


A total of 692 responses obtained from students were analysed as shown below.



Graphical Analysis: a) Percentage Vs Parameter




The obtained feedback indicates that a good percentage of responses have received excellent/very good or good rating on all the parameters i.e., a rating of 3 or more.



Graphical Analysis: c) Average Score Vs Parameter




As per the responses and average scores obtained, most of the students were satisfied with the curriculum and overall teaching-learning process in the institution. However, the students had some suggestions such as:


- More focus should be on practical life situations and skill development

- Provide better lab equipment, books in library


All these suggestions were taken cognizance of, deliberated upon and suitable steps were taken.


2. Feedback from Teachers






Here as well, the obtained feedback indicates that a good percentage of responses have received excellent/ very good or good rating on all the parameters i.e., a rating of 3 or more.

Graphical Analysis: c) Average Score Vs Parameter




Majority of the faculty agreed that work environment was good, and they were largely satisfied with the facilities and opportunities provided by the college. However, they had certain suggestions such as:


- Provide more smart boards for classrooms

- ✤ More FDPs or faculty training programs shall be organised




Graphical Analysis: a) Percentage Vs Parameter





Graphical Analysis: b) Percentage of responses having rating 3 or more Vs Parameter




Graphical Analysis: c) Average Score Vs Parameter







Graphical Analysis: a) Percentage Vs Parameter



Graphical Analysis: c) Average Score Vs Parameter






The alumni were also very satisfied with the academic environment, discipline, quality of teaching, industrial exposure, training and placement of the college and were eager to contribute to the college in whatever ways they could. Feedback from alumni suggested that Practical training, internships should be provided and there should


be training for the Competitive exams for the students. The suggestions were deliberated upon and necessary actions were taken.


Feedback from Employers






Graphical Analysis: a) Percentage Vs Parameter




As can be seen from the responses and average scores obtained for each point, the students were satisfied with the teachers. The obtained feedback indicates that a good percentage of responses have received excellent/ very good or good rating on all the parameters i.e., a rating of 3 or more.
